NATIONAL GUARD FLW COLLEGE FISHING

FLW Outdoors once again reasserted itself as the world leader in tournament fishing when it announced the FLW College Fishing trail in May 2008. Shortly after announcing the trail, the National Guard demonstrated their commitment to this sport and our country's youth by becoming the title sponsor.

The success of National Guard FLW College Fishing in its inaugural season was unprecedented. Hundreds of bass clubs were formed throughout the country at colleges and universities. Students were able to participate in a sport with little or no cost to them and were given the opportunity to win tremendous prizes for their club and school. The sport saw full fields in each region and the 25 best collegiate bass teams competed for the National Guard FLW College Fishing National Championship in Knoxville, Tenn., on Fort Loudon-Tellico lakes, in April 2010.

The University of Florida, represented by Jake Gipson and Matthew Wercinski, came from behind to take the first-ever championship in *FLW College Fishing*. The duo outperformed 24 other clubs to win \$50,000 for their school and \$25,000 and a new Ranger boat for their club.

Gipson and Wercinski were also named to the first FLW College Fishing All-America team which was selected by members of FLW Outdoors Magazine. The 20 anglers selected were chosen based on individual efforts and team contribution during the 2009 season.

College Fishing was established to grow the sport of bass fishing and allow student athletes the opportunity to compete against one another, earn scholarships and prizes for their respective clubs and schools, and gain valuable knowledge and experience competing on the same waters as some of the best professional anglers in the sport today, all at no expense to the students.

FLW Outdoors provides boats and observers for all participants, who compete as two-person teams in each qualifying event. Scholarships are awarded to the top five teams and their respective schools in each event and every team participating receives a travel allowance. The top five teams from each qualifying tournament advance to one of five nationally televised regional championships and the top five teams from each regional

advance to the national championship. The National Guard FLW Collegiate National Champion is invited to the Forrest Wood Cup, where they will be provided use of a Chevy truck and Ranger boat wrapped in their school colors as they compete for the highest award in bass fishing against the best anglers in the world.

Each school represented in a televised regional championship, held on a school's campus in conjunction with the College Fishing Festival, has custom team jerseys from FLW Outdoors and boats provided by Ranger. The purse for each regional championship will be a Ranger 177TR with a 90-horsepower outboard wrapped in school colors for the winning club and \$12,500, along with \$12,500 for the school they represent. Awards of \$5,000 extend through fifth-place for the club and school to split.

The National Guard FLW College Fishing National Championship for the 2010 season, held on the campus of Murray State University in Murray, Ky., in April 2011, will be a three-day televised event hosting the top five teams from each regional — 25 total teams. The teams will be provided with custom team jerseys and wrapped Ranger boats towed by Chevy trucks for this competition. The purse for the 2010 championship will range from \$25,000 cash and a Ranger 177TR with a 90-horsepower outboard wrapped in school colors and \$50,000 for the school they represent to the winners down to \$15,000 for fifth, split between the club and school.

The entry fee for all this is zero. Participation is free and open to all full-time students who belong to a fishing club recognized by a four-year university or college, provided participants are also FLW Outdoors members.

FLW Outdoors created CollegeFishing.com to give students a site designed around this program. CollegeFishing.com offers them a forum to discuss topics and meet other collegiate anglers, the ability to view and use footage of themselves on the water and offer them assistance at starting a club at their school, ordering team jerseys and more. CollegeFishing.com is the site for all information surrounding National Guard FLW College Fishing.

All teams receive a travel allowance based on distance traveled to the tournament. The top five teams from each qualifying event advance to a regional championship. The top five teams from each of the five regional championships advance to the national championship. The winning team of the national championship will qualify for the Forrest Wood Cup. The team will also receive use of a Ranger boat and Chevy truck wrapped in school colors. All prize money earned in the Forrest Wood Cup will go directly to the individual who earns it.
